- 3.2. Describe the actions their organisation expects them to take if a child, young person or vulnerable adult alleges or discloses harm or abuse.
- 3.3. Explain the importance of using a person-centred approach in situations where abuse is suspected or alleged.
- 3.4. Explain the rights that children, young people or vulnerable adults and their families have in situations where harm or abuse is suspected or alleged.
