If an eligible prospective student does this, and applies before the 15th January UCAS deadline, LSBU will issue the relevant benefit as indicated in the benefits table. This may include issuing a conditional or unconditional offer\*, or initially offering an interview prior to a decision being made. Applications received after 15th January will be considered on a case by case basis, pending availability of the programme selected. The prospective student has the choice of whether to accept or decline an offer of a place from LSBU. Offers made to applicants are subject to UK Visas and Immigration, and EU regulations (where applicable).

\* This is subject to the LSBU Admissions Policy on the LSBU website, relating to applicants with criminal convictions.

### Review of Agreement

The Partnership Agreement may be reviewed on an annual basis with the agreement of both parties.

### Expiry of Agreement

The Partnership Agreement may expire 18 months after the final signatory date if this agreement is not reviewed and renewed in writing.

### Termination of Agreement

The Partnership Agreement in respect of any or all of the sections listed above may be terminated by any of the signatories to this agreement, by giving at least three months' notice in writing.
