



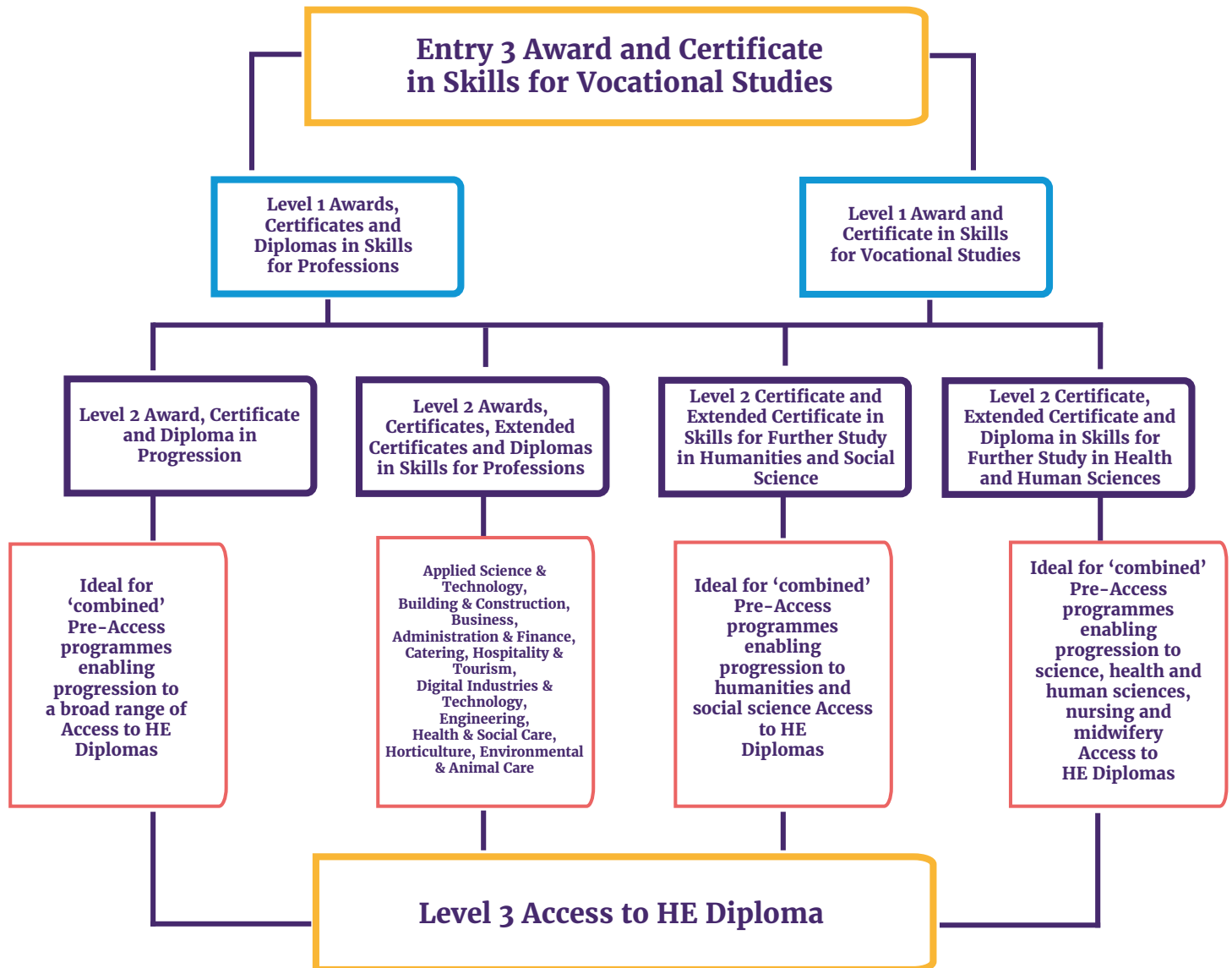

OUR PRE-ACCESS QUALIFICATIONS

Entry 3

OCNLR Entry Level Award in Skills for Vocational Studies (Entry 3) (9 credits)

OCNLR Entry Level Certificate in Skills for Vocational Studies (Entry 3) (32 credits)

These qualifications combine units from 12 vocational pathways alongside learning and employability skills, English, maths and ICT.

Level 1

OCNLR Level 1 Award in Skills for Vocational Studies (9 credits)

OCNLR Level 1 Certificate in Skills for Vocational Studies (32 credits)

These qualifications combine units from 11 vocational pathways in the Level 1 Skills for Professions (see below) with additional units in maths and engineering. They have been designed to provide learners with the flexibility to study units from more than one vocational sector.

OCNLR Level 1 Awards in Skills for Professions (9 credits)

OCNLR Level 1 Certificates in Skills for Professions (32 credits)

Available in 11 pathways, this suite of qualifications includes a range of learning and employability skills units. They are ideal for learners who wish to develop essential study skills along with vocational units to create a firm foundation for successful progression to Level 2 qualifications.

Level 2

OCNLR Level 2 Award in Progression (9 credits)

OCNLR Level 2 Certificate in Progression (25 credits)

OCNLR Level 2 Diploma in Progression (45 credits)

This suite of qualifications provides learners with the opportunity to extend their learning in preparation for additional studies in further or higher education settings. They include a large number of units spanning a wide range of vocational areas and skill sets. Their size makes them ideal to be delivered alongside GCSE English and/or maths.

OCNLR Level 2 Certificate and Extended Certificate in Skills for Further Study in Humanities and Social Science (16 credits/25 credits)

OCNLR Level 2 Certificate, Extended Certificate and Diploma in Skills for Further Study in Health and Human Sciences (18 credits / 26 credits/39 credits)

These qualifications are designed to provide learners with a wide range of knowledge and academic skills within these vocational sectors, as well as enabling them to improve their literacy, numeracy, digital skills and study skills.

OCNLR Level 2 Awards in Skills for Professions (6 credits)

OCNLR Level 2 Certificates in Skills for Professions (16-18 credits)

OCNLR Level 2 Extended Certificates in Skills for Professions (26 credits)

OCNLR Level 2 Diplomas in Skills for Professions (37 credits)

This suite of qualifications provides learners with the opportunity to extend their learning in preparation for higher level vocational and academic courses, including apprenticeships, within one of seven vocational areas. Their size makes them ideal to be delivered alongside GCSE English and/or maths.
